

ADMISSIONS POLICY

Getting to Know Us

We know what an important decision it is to choose the best school for your child. It is important for you to know the ethos of the school and how it will fit in with your child's learning style. We would encourage you to make an appointment with the Senior Leadership Team to discuss how your child's educational needs would be met at Lammas.

Admission

Entrance to the school is by interview and assessment. Children spend a taster day in the school for assessment of their academic standard, behaviour and attitude, ready for placing in the class best suited to their age. On acceptance, a non-refundable registration fee of £250 is payable immediately. Thereafter a £500 deposit is payable at the end of the term before entrance, which is deducted from annual fees.

For the primary school, the child may be admitted to Lammas in the September following their fifth birthday. For the senior school, students are normally accepted at any time in years 7, 8 and 9, although older students may be accepted. For acceptance into the sixth form, students are expected to hold at least five GCSEs, grades 5 and above, in appropriate subjects including English and mathematics.
